#### **2024 AORC National Rider Number Allocation Process**

The following document outlines the process to apply for a rider number in the 2024 Australian Off-Road Championship. In 2024 riders may register a one-digit two-digit or three-digit number.

- A rider must have competed in Six (6) rounds (i.e 3 x 2 round weekends) of the 2024 season to reserve their number in 2024.
- A rider may only register one number for 2024.
- If a rider does not compete in Six (6) rounds (i.e 3 x 2 round weekends) in 2024 their number may be forfeited.
- You may only run your State Number if you are racing in the State you hold your Senior or Junior National Licence, otherwise you must race with a National Number. Riders can register their State Number as their National Number if it is available.
- Should a rider intend to compete in a State Championship concurrently with the AORC, MA recommends they **first contact the State** to confirm availability of their desired State number, should they wish to run the same for both championships.
- All rider numbers will be allocated with the letter A (Australia) at the <u>end</u> of the number to represent that it is a national number (must not be sublimated into number, must be standalone)
- The Letter A is only required to be 1/4 the size of your race number on the front number plate
- All number plates on all machines MUST comply with GCR 10.12.1.5 and MUST include the AORC plate graphic that can be found at www.aorc.org.au
- Plates must also not contain any decals or advertising other than the required decal.

If any of the following apply to a rider, you will need to complete a Rider Number Application:

- The rider is new to the Championship;
- The rider was inactive in 2024;
- The rider did not compete in six (6) rounds in 2024;
- The rider holds an existing number from 2024 but elects to change the number for 2024;

It is the rider's responsibility to confirm whether your number was carried over from 2024, please check the 2024 AORC Rider Number Allocation document.

The rider that finished in position 1-5 in their class in the 2024 Championship and would like to run their finishing number for 2024 (rider must be remaining in the same class and only applies for E1, E2, E3, EJ and Women's Class)

A rider may elect to request a number between 1 and 5 based on their 2024 AORC Championship placing. The rider's existing number will be reserved for one (1) year, after which they can return to that number.

### **Application Process:**

- 1. Download the 2024 Rider Number Allocation document from <a href="www.aorc.org.au">www.aorc.org.au</a>
- 2. Determine if a Rider Number Application is required.
- 3. Identify three (3) desired numbers in order of preference for appropriate class of competition.
- 4. Complete the 2024 AORC Rider Number Application from www.aorc.org.au
- 5. List your three preferences and return as instructed.
